What are the "Accident Avoidance Workshops"?

The most personal and relevant skill training program available, period. We cover what "driver's ed" cannot ... namely, how to handle a car when your lives depends on it. This parent-participation program is done in your own car, ... it shows your student how fast accidents happen, ... and it trains them how to react, so when faced with that inevitable emergency, they have already practiced how to respond.

It's best to attend once they have their permit, and you have spent 6-10 hours in an empty parking lot. The bad habits start taking a set at about the 30 day mark, and get harder to break as time passes. Naturally, you want to train them how to handle an emergency before you subject them to one. It's just the ol' "Give them the gun safety class ... and THEN hand them the loaded weapon" mentality.

An 8+ hour program delivered in 2 parts:

- 1- A 3+ hour classroom session held on a weeknight,
(Classroom times: 6:24 p.m. to 9:59 p.m.)
- 2- One 5-hour driving sessions on that following weekend.
(Driving times: Morning from 7:00 to 12:15 p.m., or afternoon from 1:15 to 6:30 p.m.*)
(*may shift depending on available daylight after savings time begins)
