This is a physiological approach, from the scientific angle of a Crash Investigator your teen will enjoy! It's the physics and psychology of driving. It's the stuff you DON'T get in "driver's ed".

What are the "Accident Avoidance Workshops"?

The most relevant and personal, skill development training program available, ... period. We cover what "driver's ed" cannot; how to handle a car when their lives depends on it. This parent-participation program is done in your own vehicle, and we train them how to react so when they are faced with that emergency you know is inevitable, they have already seen how fast it can happen, and have already practiced how to respond.

It's best to attend once they have their permit, and you have spent 6-10 hours in an empty parking lot. The bad habits start taking a set at about the 30 day mark, and get harder to break as time passes. Naturally, you want to train them how to handle an emergency before you subject them to one. It's just the ol' "Give them the gun safety class ... and THEN hand them the loaded weapon" mentality.

An 8+ hour program delivered in 2 parts:

- 1- A 3+ hour classroom session held on a weeknight, (Classroom times: 6:24 p.m. to 9:59 p.m.)
- 2- One 5+ hour driving sessions on that following weekend. (Driving times: Morning from 7:00 to 12:15 p.m., or afternoon from 1:15 to 6:30 p.m.*)
(*may shift depending on available daylight after savings time begins)



The cost: Thanks to sponsors and Partners in Education, the regular price of

\$599 has been reduced to **\$396 per parent/student team**, ... or about 1/3 of your insurance deductible. Also, you can do a double-parent upgrade for \$60 so ALL of you could be eligible for Defensive Driving Certificates, which can significantly reduce your insurance rates if you haven't done so in the past 3 years as recommended.
