What are the "Accident Avoidance Workshops"?

The most current, personal and relevant skill training program available, period. We teach what "driver's ed" does not: How to handle things when lives depends on it. This parent-participation program is done in your student's own vehicle, shows them how fast crashes happen, and trains them how to react in those situations, so when your student is faced with that inevitable emergency, they have already practiced how to handle it.

This can cut your insurance rates over \$1500 a year for 3 consecutive years.

We also know that's not what is most important to the families who take this. It's just the icing on the cake.

Registration tip: Since we DO NOT BILL anyone prior to two weeks before your selected event's classroom session, we recommend you reserve a space for yourself by registering early so the event cannot sell out from underneath you. You may withdraw all the way up until the day before billing ... no harm, no foul, no penalty, no fee.

This is an 8+ hour program delivered in 2 parts:

- 1- A 3+ hour classroom session held on a weeknight prior to the weekend, (Classroom times: 6:24 p.m. to 9:58 p.m.)
- 2- One 5-hour driving sessions on that following weekend. (Driving times: Morning from 7:00 to 12:15 p.m., or afternoon from 1:00 to 6:15 p.m.)

What does it cost?: Regular price: \$499. But ... thanks to our supporters and Partners in Education, ALL 2017 venues are offering this program for **\$305 per parent/student team, (\$194 off)**. Also, for just an additional \$40, you may add a second parent, so all 3 of you could be eligible for Defensive driving Certificates ... which can significantly cut your insurance rates if you haven't done so in the past 3 years.

When is the best time to enroll?: You should want to train your student how to handle an emergency before you subject them to that very real possibility by letting them drive on public roads. It's the same as the old, "Give them the gun safety class ... and THEN hand them the weapon" mentality.

Once they get their permit, and you've spent enough time with them in a parking lot getting them comfortable/fluent operating the vehicle, we like to train them before the bad habits begin to take a set, which usually happens around the 30-day mark.

But no, ... one is never "exempt" from being faced with a crash situation and therefore never "outgrows" the need for training on how to react appropriately when everything goes horribly wrong.
